## PLANTING GUIDE AND LANDSCAPE INFORMATION

### Top 5

- Miscanthus sinensis 'Variegatus' - n  
(this is pronounced as it sounds- miss- can-thus)  
- I just love this ornamental grass, particularly this variegated form, which gives this plant a real 'silvery' look. Its got gorgeous, fine, weeping leaves, and silky, fan shaped flowers that extend up above the leaves. (flowers from Summer to Autumn). It tolerates most soil types, loves full sun, and a wide temperature range. Grows to 2-2.5m, and lots hot as a feature plant in garden bed, or even better, when it is mass planted.
- Hesperaloe parvifolia  
- The name of this small group of plants is made up of the word 'Aloe' and the Greek prefix 'hesper' which refers to the place these plants come from- being south western USA and Mexico. But don't be tricked into thinking this is an 'Aloe', because its not! Nor is it a Yucca, even though some people do call this plant Red Yucca. In tough, dry conditions, these guys are king. The fibres down the leaves generally detach, giving the plant a somewhat 'hairy' look. The flowers get up to about 1m, with pinkish, red bell shaped flowers. This guy looks hot planted in small groups, with 'like-minded' plants!
- Viburnum odoratissimum (Common name- Sweet Viburnum)  
- Screening, screening, screening. How often do we landscapers get asked about what the best screening plants is to use. The best advice I can give you, is to plant according to the conditions. That means soil type, aspect (sun or shade), temperature range. Also make sure you have enough space for the plant you want to grow. This one in particular likes to put on a bit of bulk, it likes a little room to thicken up, so probably not suitable for down the side of the house if you only have 1metre to spare. But it is a great a alternative to Murraya, lush, big, light green leaves, clusters of small

white flowers in spring, reasonably fast growing. But remember, if you are going to use this one, grab yourself a pair of good quality secateurs for pruning, cause you will damage the big leaves too much if you take to it with a hedger or pair of shears.

- Euphorbia characais – Sharon, call me about this pronunciation.  
-This plant comes from the Euphorbia family, and the diversity of this group is just amazing. There are over 2000 species of annuals, perennials, shrubs and trees in the group 'Euphorbia.' One of the most attractive parts of many of these plants are the showy bracts that appear in Spring and Summer. Now what we are looking at here, is not actually the flower- this is the bract and technically this is a leaf, which acts to help attract pollinators. The actual flower is right down here in the centre of the bract. (DEMONSTRATE). They love a sunny position, preferably with well drained, moist soil. And the temperature range depends on the variety. Just remember to wear gloves when handling all Euphorbias, because they have a milky sap which may cause skin irritations.

**Feature trees- Sharon, these trees are super advanced stock, delivered separately to main plant delivery.**

- Robinia pseudoacacia 'Frisia'- Common Name- Golden Robinia  
These trees became common back in the 80's and are still popular today because of their size, shape when fully mature, and awesome foliage colour. They are a deciduous tree, and like a sunny spot, protected from strong winds. The biggest downside to these trees is that they will sucker, (which means they send up[ shoots from the roots under the ground) and these suckers need to be removed as soon as possible to avoid them growing up into large trees.
- Ulmus parvifolia- Common Name- Chinese Elm  
One of my favourites if you are looking for a tree with that classic clear trunk, wide canopy 'tree' shape. Grows to 7-10metres, small dark green leaves, deciduous or semi deciduous depending on the temperature, ornamental greyish-brown bark. Looks great up- lit as a feature in the garden.
